



Great Lakes Shipyard Clinches \$1.9 Million NY Power Authority Barge Contract

Cleveland, OH - Great Lakes Shipyard, a member of The Great Lakes Group, Cleveland, Ohio, has been contracted by the New York Power Authority to fabricate and deliver a new 80'00" x 34'00" x 5'00" Pedestal Crane Barge for the Authority's Niagara River Ice Boom Operations in Buffalo, NY. Delivery is scheduled for October 2010. The contract, valued at nearly \$1.9 Million, is the Shipyard's first order from the Authority.

The order includes the installation of a new Terex 80-ton pedestal mounted lattice boom crane, a 3-drum deck winch manufactured by Eagle Hoist & Winch Company, and a CCTV system.

The barge design also includes a deck house, electrical and navigation systems, spuds and spud wells, a boat hoist and outfitting. The barge was designed by Bristol Harbor Design Group, Bristol, RI, which the Authority has also retained to act as their representatives during construction.

The barge will be built in Great Lakes Shipyard's new state-of-the-art fabrication shop on the Cuyahoga River in Cleveland, OH; and delivered to the Authority's Buffalo Ice Boom Operations Dock by The Great Lakes Towing Company, another member of The Great Lakes Group.
